### Context and Rationale

WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) is a critical life-saving sector in humanitarian emergencies and plays a fundamental role in protecting public health, dignity, and access to essential services. As humanitarian crises become increasingly complex due to protracted conflicts, climate-related shocks, and growing vulnerabilities, there is an increasing need for robust and standardized analytical approaches to better understand and address WASH insecurity.

### Project Overview

The WASH Insecurity Analysis (WIA) is a collaborative initiative led by UNICEF and the Global WASH Cluster, bringing together a broad range of stakeholders, including government counterparts, academic institutions, technical partners, and humanitarian actors, to strengthen the evidence base for WASH decision-making. Through this assignment, iMMAP contributes specialized Knowledge Management and Analysis expertise to support the implementation, documentation, and dissemination of the WIA. This includes supporting stakeholder engagement and mapping processes, strengthening knowledge management approaches, contributing to the development of ten contextualized WIA reports, and producing visualization and communication products that enhance the accessibility and use of WIA findings. The project also supports learning, knowledge sharing, and stakeholder engagement through the documentation of lessons learned, dissemination activities, and the development of practical knowledge products that help translate WIA findings into evidence-informed advocacy, planning, preparedness, and investment decisions.

### Expected Outcomes

- Develop stakeholder mapping to identify key decision-makers, influencers, and partners relevant to the WIA advocacy objectives;
  - Create knowledge management framework and strategy, including automated processes, connection with other data platforms;
- Contribute to the development of 10 contextualized WIA reports, including documenting key learnings and findings per country implementation;
- Produce visualization material to document WIA progress.
